HOW TO FIND US

Aim for the intersection, on Derby Ring Road, of the A52/A38 and follow the A38 (North). Take the first exit (by Derby University) and continue along Kedleston Road towards Quarndon, follow the Brown Tourist Signs for the Hall.

If using a Satnav the National Trust recommend using the Post Code DE22 5JD which will take you to the Main Entrance to the Park. Parking is then in 200 yards.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

A GNAS/Archery GB (N.T.) card must be shown at Visitor Reception to gain access to the ground for the archer and a supporter. Additional family or friends accompanying archers should obtain tickets to visit the garden (or house).
